### Participant Guidelines and Rules

**BhagavadGita Chanting:** Elementary participants must recite all the slokas from 6 to 10 slokas in Ch.1. Intermediate participants must recite all the slokas from 11 to 20 slokas in Ch. 1. Higher participants are asked to recite the slokas with meaning of choice from the judges from the slokas 11 to 20 in Ch. 1.

**Duration:** 2:30 hour

**Judging Criteria:** Participants are judged based on the clarity of pronunciation, fluency of chanting, general presentation skills including confidence.

**Elementary & Intermediate Coloring:** A drawing based on BhagavadGita theme will be given to the participants at the time of the competition. Please bring your own coloring material (crayons/ color pencils, etc NO MARKERS PLEASE).

**Higher Drawing/Coloring:** A topic based on BhagavadGitha theme Drawing or Coloring based upon the participants choice is given at the venue. Please bring your own drawing/coloring material (crayons/ color pencils, etc).

**Duration:** 30 minutes

**Judging Criteria:** Participants are judged based on their knowledge of the topic, creative and imaginative use of colors, neatness, and overall skill. Drawing will carry more weight than the coloring.

**Quiz:** Quiz questions based on BhagavadGitha will be asked to the participants. Teams will be formed by the judges at the competition venue.

**Duration:** 30 minutes

There will also be a fun on the spot BhagavadGitha theme interactive Spelling Bee for all the kids. No trophies will be awarded for this event.

**Attire:** All participants are highly encouraged (but not required) to dress in comfortable traditional Indian attire for the competition.
